LETTER OF REPRIMAND

On Wednesday July 12, 2017 a Hearing Panel of the Southern Nevada Disciplinary Panel convened to determine whether your representation of a client violated the Rules of Professional Conduct.

In this case, you represented your client in a probate matter. Thereafter, communication between yourself and your client broke down and you mutually terminated representation.

After your representation ended, you failed to withdraw from the case in a timely fashion. Because you did not withdraw appropriately several important documents were sent from the probate court to your office which were not forwarded on to your former client. This delayed the case inappropriately.

As such, you violated Rule of Professional Conduct 1.16 (Declining or Terminating Representation) and are hereby **REPRIMANDED**
