2018 GLS Scholarship Recipient

The Gaming Law Section (GLS) of the State Bar of Nevada and William S. Boyd School of Law are pleased to announce the selection of Crystal Knowles as the Fall recipient of the GLS Scholarship in the amount of \$5,000. Crystal will commence her studies for the LL.M. in Gaming Law and Regulation in August 2018.



Crystal is the Chief Counsel for the Gaming Board for the Bahamas and previously worked for the largest casino and resort development in the Caribbean, Baha Mar Ltd. Crystal received her LL.B. in law from the University of the West Indies in Barbados. She hopes to be “among the first group of attorneys in The Bahamas to obtain a professional designation in the area of gaming law, which will bode well for the development of more local legal expertise in the gaming industry.”

The LL.M. in Gaming Law and Regulation premiered in August 2015, and has enrolled recent graduates and practitioners from across the United States and around the globe. Graduates of the program have transitioned into positions with law firms and organizations, including the Nevada Gaming Control Board, William Hill, Aristocrat, and CG Technologies.

An additional \$5,000 scholarship will be available for students for Spring 2019 term. The LL.M. is still accepting applications for Spring courses starting in January.
