REPORTS

Discipline Report

Dan Hooge presented the report from the Office of Bar Counsel (OBC). Mr. Hooge explained the intake process and provided an overview of the current caseload in the OBC. The Board requested the OBC to draft a procedure for informing the Board when a significant or newsworthy complaint is filed.

Report on Board of CLE

Paul Matteoni reported on the recent meeting with the Board of CLE (Board). The meeting topics included discussion of moving Board operations to the Northern Nevada Bar Center, the Board's proposed provider fees and the proposed new attorney reporting process.

Reciprocity Taskforce Report

Ann Morgan presented an overview of the petition filed with the Supreme Court, ADKT 0538 In the matter of amendments to Supreme Court Rules about limited admission to the practice of law. Ms. Morgan also noted the taskforce recently met and will be sending a survey to members of the state bar seeking member viewpoints on reciprocity.

ACTION ITEMS

Financial Report December 31, 2018

Marc Mersol gave an overview of the financials as of December 31, 2018. Mr. Mersol highlighted that the year-end financials were very close to projections. It was moved, seconded, and carried to accept the December 31, 2018 financial report.

ADKT BOG Terms

Rick Pocker discussed the ADKT regarding the Board of Governor term limits. After discussion, it was moved, seconded, and carried to file an amendment to ADKT 0519 seeking a change for Board terms -- the lifetime term limit of the Board of Governors to 12 years (15 years if elected vice president, president-elect, or president) and that Board members hold three-year terms.

ADKT Lawyer Wellness

The proposed ADKT would amend SCR 106.5 to define the state bar's two attorney wellness programs Lawyers Concerned for Lawyers and the Nevada Lawyer Assistance Program (NLAP) and include NLAP under the Rule's confidentiality and immunity provisions. It was moved, seconded, and carried to approve the ADKT amending SCR 106.5.

Intellectual Property Section Comment Request

The Intellectual Property Section requested permission to submit written comments on the 2019 Revised Subject Matter Eligibility Guidance, and the Computer-Implemented Functional Claim Limitations Guidance issued by the USPTO.

It was moved, seconded, and carried to approve the section moving forward with comments noting that the comments are endorsed by the section only and that the section send draft comments to the Executive Committee for approval before submitting to the USPTO.
