SEPTEMBER 14, 2016

CALL TO ORDER

President Bryan Scott called the meeting to order with a quorum present at 1:50 pm.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Bryan Scott reviewed the status of proposed business plan of the Board of Continuing Legal Education. He also presented an overview of the public hearing regarding the ADKT before the Supreme Court on Medical Marijuana.

DISCUSSION

Advertising Rules

Kim Farmer discussed the current Advertising rules. Ms. Farmer then presented a few questions to the Board to generate a discussion.

- > Do the rules for advertising protect the public?
- Why do we need a Northern and a Southern Advertising Committee?
- Should the lawyer advertising rules also pertain to social media?

In order to answer these questions, a taskforce was formed. Gene Leverty, chair, Kari Stephens, Ryan Russell, and Eric Dobberstein. Two Advertising Committee members will also be appointed.

o LRIS Grants Program

Kim Farmer discussed the Lawyer Referral and Information Service (LRIS) yearly Public Service Grants Program. Ms. Farmer noted that LRIS revenue has steadily declined in the past 5 years and asked the Board to consider ceasing the LRIS grant program for 2017. After an extensive discussion it was moved, seconded and carried to continue the LRIS Public Service Grant Program for 2017.

CALL TO ORDER

President Bryan Scott called the meeting to order with a quorum present at 8:45 am.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT

Kim Farmer reviewed the Executive Summary of Keller and Related Case Law.

Judge Michael Montero presented an overview of his diverse duties as a District Court Judge in the Sixth Judicial District in Nevada. Judge Montero stressed the shortage of attorneys in the rural districts and the ongoing challenge to recruit attorneys to practice in rural Nevada.

LAW SCHOOL REPORT

Dean Dan Hamilton of the UNLV Boyd School of Law presented recent statistics regarding the law school. Dean Hamilton highlighted that the Boyd School of Law in under 20 years has become one of the top public law schools in the country. Scholarships make the difference in attracting top students to Boyd School of Law. Dean Hamilton talked about the increase of yearly tuition yet Boyd Law is still below its closest competitors.

DISCIPLINE REPORT

Statistics

Stan Hunterton gave an overview of the progress that the Office of Bar Counsel (OBC) is making with the discipline backlog. Mr. Hunterton mentioned the concern regarding the investigation backlog but highlighted the steps being taken to correct this backlog. Bryan Scott discussed comments from Chief Justice Parraguirre regarding inconsistent discipline recommendations by the panels. The Board discussed using the Federal sentencing guidelines as a potential model for discipline.

Mock Trial Rules and Subcommittees

The Mock Trial Committee reviewed its rules as they compared to the National High School Mock Trial Competition. The Committee requested approval from the Board for the proposed revisions in keeping with the National Rules. It was moved, seconded and carried to approve the revisions to the Mock Trial Rules.

Judicial Selection

It was moved, seconded and carried to appoint Tara Newberry as a temporary member to the Commission on Judicial Selection.

Real Property Section -- Michael Buckley, Doug Flowers, and John Leach presented the proposed legislative changes of the Real Property Section of the State Bar of Nevada. It was moved, seconded and carried that the section may assert that the positions discussed are endorsed by the section only.
