OF MODIFYING THE HOMICIDE TEAM AND
REASSIGNING CIVIL CASES

Administrative Order: 20-20

Rule 1.30(b) of the Rules of Practice for the Eighth Judicial District Court charges the Chief Judge of the Eighth Judicial District Court with various responsibilities, including supervising the administrative business of the District Court, ensuring the quality and continuity of court services, supervising the court calendar, reassigning cases as convenience or necessity requires, assuring the court's duties are timely and orderly performed, and otherwise facilitating the business of the District Court. *See also* NRS 3.025.

The Eighth Judicial District Court formed a Homicide Team consisting of four district court judges by way of Administrative Order 17-05. This team centralized the management of homicide cases to efficiently and timely dispose of such cases. The team has changed from time to time through Administrative Orders 18-06 and 19-01. This Court now further modifies the team and case assignments.

Accordingly, under Rule 1.30(b), effective September 8, 2020, Department 10 shall replace Department 3 on the Homicide Team. Department 10 shall serve as the Homicide Team Case Management Judge. The civil cases in Department 10 shall be reassigned to Department 3. Court Administration shall attach a list of the reassigned cases as an exhibit to this order.
