DOMESTIC CASES IN DEPARTMENT L

Administrative Order: 20-19

Rule 1.30(b) of the Rules of Practice for the Eighth Judicial District Court charges the Chief Judge of the Eighth Judicial District Court with various responsibilities, including supervising the administrative business of the District Court, ensuring the quality and continuity of Court services, supervising the court calendar, reassigning cases as convenience or necessity requires, assuring the Court's duties are timely and orderly performed, and otherwise facilitating the business of the district court. See also NRS 3.025.

In Administrative Order 20-15, this Court directed civil domestic cases pending in Department L to be heard by senior judges or other district court judges. This Court now modifies this assignment to further foster consistency, efficiency, and fairness.

Accordingly, under Rule 1.30(b), effective retroactively to July 6, 2020, civil domestic cases pending in Department L will be randomly reassigned to the remaining civil domestic district court judges until further notice. Court Administration shall attach a list of reassigned cases as an exhibit to this order.
