While the names of the successful candidates of the February 2017 Nevada Bar Examination (“Bar Exam”) **HAVE NOT YET BEEN ANNOUNCED**, this letter is to advise you of the date and location of the Admission Ceremony so that you and your family can schedule your activities accordingly.

**PLEASE FIRST NOTE THAT YOUR ADDRESS MUST BE UPDATED WITH THE ADMISSIONS DEPARTMENT AS TIME-SENSITIVE INFORMATION/DOCUMENTATION WILL OTHERWISE BE DELAYED. AFTER TEST RESULTS ARE ANNOUNCED, THE NEVADA SUPREME COURT WILL USE THE ADDRESS PROVIDED TO THE STATE BAR OF NEVADA TO CONTACT YOU.**

It is expected that the unofficial results of the February 2017 Bar Exam will be filed with the Clerk of the Nevada Supreme Court on Wednesday, **May 17, 2017**, at 3:00 p.m., Pacific Time. Bar results will then be available on the State Bar website at [www.nvbar.org](http://www.nvbar.org). **PLEASE DO NOT CALL THE ADMISSIONS DEPARTMENT OR THE NEVADA SUPREME COURT PRIOR TO THE TIME RESULTS ARE POSTED ON THE STATE BAR WEBSITE.** The Nevada Supreme Court will send a written notice to each applicant regarding the official Bar Exam results and the status of each applicant’s application for admission upon the entry of the Court’s Order concerning the official results.

You are not eligible for admission until you pass the Bar Exam, receive a passing score on the Multistate Professional Responsibility Exam, and are cleared for character and fitness. If you pass the Bar Exam and are cleared for character and fitness, please note that you are not authorized to practice law until the Nevada Supreme Court orders your admission and you have completed the Attorney’s Oath as required by SCR 73.

**Please note if you have been notified by the Admissions Department that your application has been placed on a character and fitness hold, you will not be eligible to participate in the ceremony, even if you pass the Bar Exam and even if all of your administrative documents have been received, without the prior approval of the Director of Admissions. As character and fitness reviews continue throughout the exam cycle, it is your responsibility to check with the Admissions Department before May 17, 2017 to determine the current status of your character and fitness hold. You must satisfy all requirements for admission on or before **May 17, 2017 at 12:00 p.m.** in order to participate in the Admission Ceremony. To assure your participation in the Admission Ceremony, the Admissions Department must receive your MPRE scores, official transcripts of all schools attended (undergraduate and law school), certificates of good standing, etc., by the May 17, 2017 date and time.

On the day of the Ceremony, each qualified applicant must sign in with the Clerk of the Court immediately preceding the Ceremony. Your name will **not** be announced during the Ceremony unless you sign in before the Ceremony begins.

The February 2017 Admission Ceremony will be held on Friday, May 26, 2017 at 3:30 p.m. in Carson City. The location of the Admission Ceremony is as follows:
