The meeting was called to order by President Connie Akridge at 8:42 a.m. there being a quorum present.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT, CONNIE AKRIDGE

Connie Akridge reported on the recent meeting Frank Flaherty, Kim Farmer and she had with Chief Judge Hardy. They discussed funding issues in the courts. Kim Farmer and Connie Akridge had previously met with Chief Judge Togliatti in Clark County to discuss the same matters.

Ms. Akridge also provided a synopsis on the 2012 Annual Convention to be held in San Diego at The Hotel Del Coronado.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT, KIMBERLY FARMER

Kim Farmer reported on the current staffing at the state bar. Ms. Farmer discussed the Audit Committee's recommendations to engage Houldsworth Russo & Co. for the 2011 audit of the state bar and the Nevada Bar Foundation. The Executive Committee will review the final engagement letter and approve for signature.

REPORTS

Young Lawyer's Section, Brian Gonsalves -- Brian Gonsalves reported on the latest events of the Young Lawyer's Section (YLS). The section is finishing the project to revise a new Goldilocks DVD. The YLS Executive Council is reviewing the YLS membership. The Council believes it would be beneficial to the section to have new lawyers automatically included in the section upon admission with a provision to opt out. Jess Rinehart was appointed the Northern Social Chair of the YLS.

Facilities, Jake Joyce, Applied Analysis -- Applied Analysis (AA) was retained by the Board to conduct a commercial office space financial and market assessment. The analysis was to provide input to the Board as they assess lease-purchase-build options for a 20,000-25,000 square foot building to meet the needs of the growing Las Vegas headquarters. Jake Joyce of Applied Analysis presented a summary report.

The AA report weighed the benefits and drawbacks of leasing vs. owning a building, assessed vacancy rates and analyzed market conditions in the Las Vegas market.

AA recommended that the state bar buy a building. The report sited that a building purchase (over leasing) provides:

- For investment opportunity through real estate
- The opportunity for a Class A/B building at below construction pricing
- Lower costs for a grey shell structure vs. new construction
- Stronger cash flows compared to a lease option
- The ability to finance a building with attractive financing rates
- For an asset at the end of the holding term

It was moved, seconded and approved to that the Executive Committee engage a commercial real estate broker for purposes of working with the bar to search for properties with the intent to buy a building in Las Vegas. The Executive Committee to will work with the Facilities Committee.

It was moved, seconded and approved to direct the Facilities Committee to work with the approved broker to find a building for state bar headquarters. The Board will make final decisions on any recommendations by the Committee.

Marc Mersol reported on the financial operations and information systems. Mr. Mersol covered the financial report ending November 30, 2011.

Investment Committee

Elizabeth Brickfield provided an overview on the current investments of the state bar. The Investment Committee recommended that the state bar continue working with Northern Trust Securities, Inc. through 2012. It was moved, seconded and approved to accept the report and recommendations of the Investment Committee.

Animal Law Section Bylaws Update

It was moved seconded and carried to change the term Executive Council to Executive Committee. It was moved, seconded and carried to add Section 8 to the bylaws that cover section involvement in legislation.

Advertising Committee Report to the Court

The Supreme Court issued a December 8, 2011 order on ADKT 445, Amendments to the Nevada Rules of Professional Conduct, requesting a response to comments the Court received. The Advertising Committee North and South provided a written report to the Board responding the Court's order. It was moved, seconded and approved to submit to the Supreme Court the Advertising Committee's reply to questions on ADKT 445.
