ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

Bar counsel for the State Bar of Nevada has petitioned this court to enter an order temporarily suspending attorney Brian Malcolm Keith from the practice of law under SCR 111. The petition is supported by certified copies of documents evidencing a conviction entered against Keith on May 9, 2006. Keith was convicted in the Placer County Superior Court, California, pursuant to a plea agreement, of one count of driving under the influence of alcohol and causing bodily injury, a felony under California Vehicle Code § 23153(A). Keith received a jail sentence of 16 months, with credit for 67 days.

Having reviewed the petition and the supporting documentation submitted by bar counsel, we conclude that the petition conclusively establishes Keith's conviction of a serious crime warranting temporary suspension.¹ Accordingly, we temporarily suspend Keith from the practice of law and refer this matter to the Southern Nevada Disciplinary Board for the initiation of formal disciplinary proceedings in

which the sole issue to be determined is the extent of discipline to be imposed.²


It is so ORDERED.³




