## ORDER TRANSFERRING ATTORNEY TO DISABILITY INACTIVE STATUS

Attorney Beau Sterling and the Office of Bar Counsel have jointly petitioned this court for an order transferring Sterling to disability inactive status. See SCR 117(2). We previously referred this matter to the Southern Nevada Disciplinary Board "for hearing and recommendation by a hearing panel." Id. Having reviewed the petition, the supporting documents, the transcripts of the hearing following our referral, and the hearing panel's written decision, we conclude that the relief requested in the petition is warranted because Sterling is "incapable of continuing the practice of law" due to a mental infirmity. Id. Accordingly, Sterling is transferred to disability inactive status. He may not resume active status until he files a petition for reinstatement as provide in SCR 117(4) and is reinstated by order of this court. In light of this order, any pending

disciplinary proceedings against Sterling are suspended.<sup>1</sup> SCR 117(2). The State Bar shall comply with SCR 121.1.<sup>2</sup>
