*ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR TRANSFER TO DISABILITY
INACTIVE STATUS*


This is a petition for transfer of attorney William Errico to disability inactive status pursuant to SCR 117.¹ The State Bar opposes the petition. On April 13, 2016, this court entered an order transferring Errico to disability inactive status pending determination of his capacity to continue to practice law and his ability to adequately defend the disciplinary proceedings, denying a stay of the underlying disciplinary proceedings, and referring the matter to the disciplinary panel for its recommendation in this regard.


The panel conducted a hearing on April 14, 2016. Errico has filed a status report regarding the outcome of the hearing, and the State Bar has filed the record of the hearing. Based on its findings that Errico's February 2014 stroke "has not precluded him from practicing law for the last several years" and that Errico's "other medical issues are temporary in nature and are being addressed by his current treatment," the panel recommended that Errico's SCR 117 petition be denied.

¹Errico filed an "Emergency Motion" for transfer to disability inactive status that we construe as a petition under SCR 117(3).


Having reviewed the petition, the opposition, the status report, the record of the April 14, 2016, proceedings, and all supporting documents, we approve the disciplinary panel's recommendation. Errico's petition for transfer to disability inactive status is denied. We remove Errico from his temporary placement on disability inactive status, and we reinstate the disciplinary proceedings pending against him. See SCR 117(3). The disciplinary panel shall proceed with the disciplinary proceedings pending against Errico at a date and time set by the panel chair. Further, based on our review of the documents on file in this matter, we direct bar counsel to investigate and, if appropriate, file a petition in this court pursuant to SCR 102(4)(b). See SCR 104.


It is so ORDERED.²


