CODE OF ETHICS AND PROFESSIONAL RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PARALEGAL DIVISION OF THE STATE BAR OF NEVADA

Preamble

Fundamental to the success of any professional organization are the integrity of its members and a high standard of conduct. This Code of Ethics and Professional Responsibility is promulgated by the Paralegal Division of the State Bar of Nevada and accepted by its members to accomplish these ends.

The paralegal profession is by nature closely related to the legal profession. It is incumbent upon the members of the Paralegal Division to know the provisions of the Nevada Rules of Professional Conduct and the Supreme Court Rules, and avoid any action which might involve an attorney in a violation of such rules, as well as avoid any action which may create the appearance of professional impropriety.

The canons set forth hereafter are intended as a general guide, and the enumeration of these canons does not exclude others of equal importance although not specifically mentioned.

CANON 1. A paralegal shall not engage in the practice of law as defined by statutes or court decisions, including but not limited to accepting cases or clients, setting fees, giving legal advice or appearing in a representative capacity in a court or before an administrative or regulatory agency (unless otherwise authorized by statute, court or agency rules); the paralegal shall assist in preventing the unauthorized practice of law.

CANON 2. A paralegal shall not perform any of the duties that attorneys only may perform, nor do things which attorneys themselves may not do.

CANON 3. A paralegal shall exercise care in using professional judgment in determining the extent to which a client may be assisted without the presence of any attorney. A paralegal shall not act in matters involving professional legal judgment.

CANON 4. A paralegal shall preserve and protect the confidences and secrets of a client.

CANON 5. A paralegal shall not solicit legal business on behalf of an attorney.

CANON 6. A paralegal shall not engage in performing paralegal/paralegal functions other than under the direct supervision of an attorney, and shall not advertise nor contract with members of the general public for the performance of paralegal/paralegal functions.

CANON 7. A paralegal shall avoid, if at all possible, any interest or association which constitutes a conflict of interest pertaining to a client matter and shall inform the supervising attorney of the existence of any possible conflict.

CANON 8. A paralegal shall maintain a high standard of ethical conduct and shall contribute to the integrity of the paralegal (also known as paralegal) profession.

CANON 9. A paralegal shall maintain a high degree of competency to better assist the legal profession in fulfilling its duty to provide quality legal services to the public.

CANON 10. A paralegal shall do all other things incidental, necessary or expedient to enhance professional responsibility and the participation of Paralegal in the administration of justice and public service in cooperation with the legal profession.

PARALEGAL PLEDGE OF PROFESSIONALISM

PARALEGAL DIVISION OF THE STATE BAR OF NEVADA

A paralegal is a person, qualified through education, training or work experience, who is employed or retained by a lawyer, law office, governmental agency, or other entity in a capacity or function which involves the performance, under the ultimate direction or supervision of an attorney, of specifically delegated substantive legal work, which work for the most part requires a sufficient knowledge of legal concepts that, absent such an assistant, the attorney would perform the task.

In my role as a paralegal, I aspire to a standard of conduct that warrants the term "professional." I seek to earn a reputation for honor, trustworthiness and professionalism among my employer's clients, the legal community and the community at large.

As a paralegal dedicated to the professional and ethical conduct of my profession, I will conduct myself in accordance with the following Pledge of Professionalism:

I. To an employer and his/her clients, a paralegal owes undivided allegiance, and the full application of the paralegal's abilities.

1. I will perform any task which is properly delegated and supervised by my attorney employer, so long as the attorney is ultimately responsible to the client and assumes complete professional responsibility for the work product.
2. I will disclose my status as a paralegal at the outset of any professional relationship with my attorney employer's client, other attorneys, and members of the general public.
3. I will preserve the confidences and secrets of all my attorney employer's clients.
4. I will take reasonable measures to inform my attorney employer of potential conflicts of interest arising from my other employment or interests insofar as such other employment or interests would present a conflict of interest if it were that of the lawyer.
5. I will understand the attorney's Nevada Rules of Professional Conduct and the Supreme Court Rules, in order to avoid any action which would involve the attorney in a violation of those Rules, or give the appearance of professional impropriety.
6. I will not establish attorney-client relationships with or set legal fees for any person or entity, including my attorney employer's clients; nor will I give legal opinions or legal advice to any such persons or entities. I understand and acknowledge that such matters are to be performed solely by an attorney, and not a paralegal.
7. I will not engage in, encourage, or contribute to any act which could constitute the unauthorized practice of law.

II. To the public, a paralegal owes the highest degree of professionalism and integrity.

1. I will conduct myself in a manner that will encourage trust of the legal profession by members of the public.
2. I recognize and will abide by the principle that the legal profession is devoted to public service, improvement of the administration of justice, and the uncompensated assistance to persons who cannot afford representation, and will assist my attorney employer in all efforts to meet this standard.
3. I will treat my co-workers and office employees with courtesy and respect.
4. I recognize that my conduct is governed by standards of fundamental decency and courtesy.
5. I recognize that the services of a lawyer are essential whenever the exercise of professional legal judgment is required.
